Fifteen years ago, Guido and Elke Bethge embarked on an ambitious journey by establishing BC DirectGroup in Berlin's competitive direct mail landscape. Their vision went beyond traditional printing services – they sought to revolutionise print management for direct mail and document outsourcing clients through cutting-edge technology and sustainable practices. Over the past decade, BC DirectGroup has strategically expanded their capabilities, developing sophisticated data analysis and processing expertise while nurturing their core direct mail business. This dual focus has enabled them to extend their document output services across diverse sectors, including non-profits, healthcare, real estate, financial services, and hybrid mail operators.

Technology Infrastructure and Capabilities

A powerful combination of hardware and software solutions lies at the heart of BC DirectGroup's operations. Their facility houses advanced Canon ColorStream 3000 and ColorStream 6000 web presses, working in tandem with intelligent inserting machines from industry leaders Bäuerle and Kern. This sophisticated equipment forms the backbone of their print and mailing services, capable of meeting the demands of businesses regardless of size or complexity.

Integrating cutting-edge hardware with industry-leading software technology enables BC DirectGroup to provide comprehensive security features, including piece-level tracking within a closed-loop system. This attention to detail gives clients complete confidence that their critical print and mail materials are processed precisely and delivered to the intended recipients. The robust infrastructure supports processing volumes of up to 30 million letters and approximately 105 million pages annually, positioning BC DirectGroup as a major player in the industry.



Meeting Production Challenges Head-On

The sheer scale of BC DirectGroup's operations – processing between 60,000 to 90,000 files daily from over 1,800 clients – demands exceptional workflow efficiency and automation capabilities. The company implemented a standardised PDF-based workflow for file onboarding and preparation to streamline their operations. While they continue to accept various input formats, including AFP, PCL, and PostScript, all files are converted to PDF before entering the production workflow. Many clients utilise BC DirectGroup's OnPremise Managed File Transfer solution to submit PDF documents directly.

However, the standardisation of PDF brought its own set of challenges. As the business expanded, BC DirectGroup encountered increasingly inefficiently structured PDF files. These files often originated from various sources:

- Office environment printer drivers
- Web applications utilising open-source PDF libraries
- Corporate applications in sectors like insurance, healthcare, and banking that generate complex file structures

The Challenge of PDF Optimisation

The diversity of incoming documents spans from basic letters to intricate files containing numerous pages and associated resources. Suboptimal PDF structures can significantly impact processing efficiency, potentially leading to increased processing time at the printer and, in more severe cases, triggering errors that halt production. These interruptions delay scheduled work, resulting in paper waste, and often require time-consuming reprints.

Most clients remain unaware of the technical inefficiencies in their PDF submissions. Common issues include:

- · Files bloated with numerous repeated, subsetted font families
- · Images containing unnecessarily high resolutions exceeding print requirements
- Redundant comment records added by enterprise production software
- Inefficient object referencing requiring multiple processing passes

The Search for a Solution

These challenges led BC DirectGroup to seek a robust PDF optimisation solution, ultimately leading them to Solimar Systems' ReadyPDF. Chief Operating Officer Florian Rose noted that the implementation has transformed their workflow efficiency: "We previously optimised PDF documents with third-party libraries. 
